



Regulations for shipments to and from Côte d'Ivoire

1. United Nations

The [Security Council Committee](#) ⁽¹⁾ established pursuant to [resolution 1572 \(2004\)](#) ⁽²⁾ concerning Côte d'Ivoire was established on 15 November 2004 to oversee the relevant sanctions measures and to undertake the tasks set out by the Security Council in paragraph 14 of the same resolution.

The sanctions regime and the mandate of the Committee have been modified by subsequent resolutions, most notably Security Council resolutions 1584 (2005) and 1643 (2005). The regime was most recently renewed until 30 April 2012 by paragraph 1 of [resolution 1980 \(2011\)](#) ⁽³⁾, which was adopted on 28 April 2011.

The Security Council will review the sanctions regime in light of the progress achieved in the implementation of the key steps of the peace process and of the progress of the electoral process in Côte d'Ivoire, as referred to in resolutions 1911 (2010) and 1933 (2010).

European Union imposes a set of specific restrictive measures directed against certain persons and entities in view of the situation in Côte d'Ivoire. The European sanction regime is permanently updated in the light of the progress in the country.
